

# SPEAKERS

**Dr. Jonathan Esquivel**, received his dental training at Universidad Americana in his hometown of Managua, Nicaragua. After graduating from dental school, he joined his father's practice for four years. Due to his growing interest in prosthetics, he decided to pursue a specialty training in prosthodontics at LSUSD, completing the residency in 2013. He then was accepted and completed the LSUSD Esthetics and Surgical Implant Fellowship in 2014. Dr. Esquivel has devoted much of his professional career to complex implant and esthetic therapy. He is a former Associate Professor at Louisiana State University. He has published articles on the topics of dental implants and esthetics in nationally recognized peer reviewed journals and has lectured nationally and internationally.



**Dr. Gerard Chiche** is presently Clinical Professor at Louisiana State University, School of Dentistry. He is a Past President of the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry, and he has lectured in Esthetic Dentistry nationally and internationally in 35 countries. He is the author of two textbooks in Esthetic Dentistry published by Quintessence Publishing Co. He is Emeritus Professor at Louisiana State University, and he became in 2009 the first recipient of the Endowed Chair sponsored by the Thomas P. Hinman Dental Society. Finally, he is the 2020 recipient of the Icon Award for Lifetime Achievement in Dentistry of the Seattle Study Club.

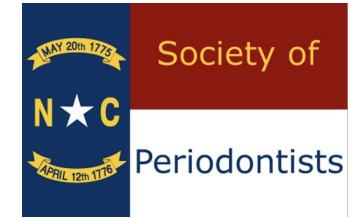

## LECTURE INFORMATION:

### Perio-Prosthodontic Protocols for Increased Treatment Success in Esthetic Dentistry

Interdisciplinary treatment planning is crucial for successful results. A clear understanding of esthetics, function, and biology by the restorative team is needed. This presentation will present key points formulated into a systematic step-by-step approach to resolve esthetic problems with predictable results and improved communication between the Prosthodontist and the Periodontist. It will cover critical details of Esthetic treatment planning and design, focusing on priorities and critical parameters following fundamental biologic concepts. Interdisciplinary esthetic communication will also address treatment decisions between surgical crown lengthening and orthodontic intrusion and specific planning protocols according to the type of final restoration, as well as well-thought-of and executed implant cases from the single tooth to the full-arch reconstruction focusing on emergence profile design and pontic site development in the esthetic area.

#### Attendees will learn:

- To implement key strategies for communicating between the Periodontal and Prosthodontic teams to idealize esthetic and functional results.
- To understand interdisciplinary treatment concepts in the esthetic zone for both dentate and partially edentulous patients.
